

# Government response stringency index

These maps give an indication how stringent the government restrictions are per country. This does not necessarily reflect the number of covid-cases or covid-deaths (for instance: Australia), but it can.

Government restrictions give an indication of how difficult it is to travel within a country and to and from a country and thus give an indication how difficult it is to work in this situation. It also may give an indication of how priorities of governments may have shifted towards fighting the pandemic, which may sometimes translate into less money and resources for IWRM.

For all partnerships it has been (nearly) impossible to travel between Netherlands and the partner country.




All partnerships stringent restrictions, with exception of Burkina Faso (low stringency) and Ghana (medium).

Argentina and Romania very stringent.

#### March 1st 2021

Peru and Colombia even more stringent, Argentina remains high stringency.


With exception of Kenya and Mozambique partner countries in Africa reduce stringency (Burkina Faso lowest)

Romania improves from highest stringency to stringent, Palestinian Territories and Vietnam remain stringent.

South America all very stringent.


In West Africa situation worsens;

In West Africa situation improves;


Situation worsens in southern Africa.

# **Summary**

**South America**: Covid situation is critical; very stringent restrictions throughout the first half year of 2021.

**West Africa**: Covid situation relatively quite good, restrictions vary but not very stringent. Best in Burkina Faso.

East Africa: Covid situation less good than West Africa; medium restrictions

Southern Africa: Covid situation worsens from the beginning of 2021 to end of first half year

**Romania**: Almost the whole first half year stringent restrictions

**Vietnam and Palestinian Territories** Almost the whole first half year stringent restrictions at the end the situation worsens
